

Main Function:

The After-School Enrichment Facilitator is a part-time position assisting children with assignments, activities, and homework, such as reading, writing, science, and math. The job was established for the purpose/s of helping students develop and strengthen academic, physical and social skills by providing assistance and tutoring to students in the afterschool program

Essential Duties:

- Providing academic tutoring and enrichment programming for designated groups of students.
- Assists students, individually or in small groups, with lesson assignments (e.g. reading stories, listening to students reading, language, spelling, facilitating activities, checks homework, etc.) for the purpose of presenting and/or reinforcing learning concepts and reaching their academic goals and potential.
- Implements instructional learning activities for the purpose of improving students' academic, physical and social skills.
- Monitors individual and/or groups of students in a variety of settings (e.g. classroom, computer lab, playground, gym, etc.) for the purpose of enforcing school rules and procedures regarding student behavior and participation and/or providing a safe, respectful and positive multicultural learning environment.
- Completing accident/incident reports accurately and submitting in a timely manner within 24 hours Enforcing all MPRD rules and regulations to maintain discipline and ensure safety of all patrons.
- Promotes good habits for the purpose of improving the quality of student's outcome and encouraging student development.
